Jan. 10 Session 3 Week 1	Nicodemus visits Jesus	John 3:1–21	Nicodemus comes at night to talk to Jesus about what it means to be born of the Spirit. Jesus says those who believe in the Son of Man will have eternal life.	Younger: God gives us new life. Older: Believe and be born again.
Jan. 17 Session 3 Week 2	Jesus and the Samaritan woman	John 4:1–42	Jesus asks a Samaritan woman for a drink and tells her about living water. She calls him a prophet. Because of her, many Samaritans come to Jesus and believe.	We yearn for living water.
Jan. 24 Session 3 Week 3	Loaves and fishes and spiritual food	John 6:1–15, 22–40	Jesus feeds a crowd of 5,000 people using five loaves and two fish. The next day, Jesus calls himself the bread of life; all who believe in him will have eternal life.	God takes our little and makes it more.
Jan. 31 Session 4 Week 4	Jesus refuses to cast stones	John 7:53–8:11	Some religious authorities bring a sinner to Jesus to see if he will enforce the law by calling for her death. Jesus tells those without sin to cast the first stone.	Younger: Stop doing wrong and make a new start. Older: Leave sinful ways and begin anew.
Feb. 7 Session 5 Week 5	Jesus heals blindness	John 9	Jesus heals a man of blindness. The healed man does not back down when challenged by the Pharisees. Jesus criticizes those who claim to see but are really blind.	Jesus can help us see God's light.
Feb. 14 Session 6 Week 6	The Good Shepherd	John 10:1–21	Jesus describes a shepherd who cares for sheep. Sheep know their shepherd's voice. Jesus calls himself the good shepherd who lays down his life for his sheep.	We trust Jesus, the good shepherd.
