They eat together along the seashore. Jesus tells Simon Peter to feed his sheep.	Younger: Jesus cares for us. Older: We care for others as Jesus cares for us.
April 18 Session 5 Week 2	God's presence on earth	John 14:15–31	Jesus says those who love him will keep his commandments. God will send another Advocate, the Holy Spirit, to teach the people. Jesus leaves the disciples his peace.	Younger: Jesus give peace. Older: The Holy Spirit teaches us in Jesus' name.
April 25 Session 5 Week 3	Jesus is the true vine	John 15:1–11	Jesus says that he is the true vine, God is the vine-grower, and listeners are the branches who are to bear good fruit. We are to keep his commandments and abide in his love.	Younger: We are rooted in God. Older: We bear fruit because we are rooted in God.
May 2 Session 5 Week 4	Loving one another	John 13:31–35; 15:12–17	Jesus says he is going away and commands the disciples to love each other as he has loved them. Jesus calls the disciples friends and sends them out to bear everlasting fruit.	As Jesus' friends, we are to love each other.
May 16 Session 5 Week 5	Abiding in God	1 John 4:7–21	God is the source of love. We can love each other because God first loved us. Those who abide in love abide in God. Those who love God love their brothers and sisters also.	God is love.
May 23 Session 5 Week 6 Pentecost	New heaven and new earth	Revelation 1:1–2; 21:1–7; 22:8–9	John envisions a new heaven and new earth where God dwells among the people, wiping away tears and putting an end to pain and mourning.	Imagine living with God in a world with no sadness.
